Today's Game: Hartford will resume America East play on Sunday at the University of Vermont. The Catamounts have won three of their last four games and are undefeated at Patrick Gymnasium (3-0). Tip-off is scheduled for 1 p.m.

Hartford's Last Game: Hartford finished as runner-up at the Oneida Bingo & Casino Classic earlier in the week, falling to host Wisconsin-Green Bay in the championship game by a 68-60 final. The Hawks, who defeated Rider 68-57 the previous day, erased a 13-point second-half deficit to take a lead with six minutes remaining in the game. The Phoenix came back to tie things up and finished the game with a 12-4 run to claim the championship. Junior Aaron Cook scored a game-high 19 points and claimed a spot on the all-tournament team while classmate David Ruffin finished with 13 points. Cook and sophomore Bo Taylor each had a team-high seven rebounds.

Scouting the Catamounts: Vermont enters today's game with a 5-3 overall record, 1-0 in the America East. The Catamounts have won three of their last four contests, the lone loss in the stretch coming at North Carolina. The preseason pick to win the America East Conference, the Catamounts opened their conference slate with a 30-point win over Binghamton on December 19. Senior Taylor Copenrath leads the conference in scoring at 25.4 ppg while classmate T.J. Sorrentine checks in at 17.3 ppg. Copenrath also leads the team in rebounding at 8.5 rpg.

The Series: Hartford and Vermont will meet for the 43rd time on Sunday. Each team has claimed 21 wins in the series, though the Catamounts have taken the last four meetings.

Last Meeting: March 7, 2004 - Vermont ended Hartford's season for the second straight year, beating the Hawks 61-48 in the semifinals of the Choice Hotels International America East Championship. Hartford led at the half but didn't score for the first nine minutes of the second half, allowing Vermont to take a lead it would never surrender. The Catamounts scored the first 11 points of the half, as Hartford missed its first 11 attempts from the floor. The Hawks finally got their first points of the stanza on a layup by Aaron Cook with 10:50 to play, cutting UVM's lead to 38-30. Hartford got as close as 46-41 before Vermont pulled away. T.J. Sorrentine scored 13 of his 18 points in the second half, including a driving layup and a three-pointer in an 11-0 run that made it 57-41 with 1:40 to play. The Hawks went scoreless again for six minutes during the stretch, ending any hope of a comeback. Cook finished with a team-high 17 points and five rebounds while Ryan Stys had 12 and Charles Ford had 11.

What Went Wrong vs. UW-Green Bay: Hartford stormed back from 13 points down in the second half to take a 53-52 lead with 6:25 to play. Then, after tying the score at 56-56 with just over five minutes remaining, the Hawks went ice cold on offense. Hartford went 4:55 without scoring a basket, missing six attempts while committing two turnovers during the stretch. The Phoenix closed the game on a 12-4 run.

Up Next: Hartford will play its final non-conference game of the season against Longwood University on Tuesday, January 4 at the Reich Family Pavilion. Tip-off is scheduled for 7 p.m.

Tough Stretch: Today's game at Vermont kicks off a tough stretch for the Hawks. Hartford will play four games over the next seven days, including road contests against conference heavyweights Vermont and Boston University and home games against Longwood and UMBC. The last time the Hawks played as many games in a seven-day period was in 2001 at the Las Vegas Invitational. Hartford played four games in six days and lost all four games.

America East Notes: The Hawks are 14-7 all-time in conference openers since joining the North Atlantic Conference for the 1984-85 season ... last season Hartford opened the conference season with a loss at Maine (87-63) ... the Hawks finished sixth in the conference last season with a 6-12 record ... Hartford was 5-4 in conference home games last season and just 1-8 in conference road games (the one victory was at New Hampshire) ... the North Atlantic Conference merged with the Seaboard Conference in 1989 and later changed its name to the America East Conference prior to the 1996-97 academic year.

Cook Gets Going: Junior guard Aaron Cook broke out of a scoring slump at the Oneida Bingo & Casino Classic. After averaging only 8.8 ppg over the previous six games, Cook exploded for 23 points against Rider and 19 in the loss to UW-Green Bay. He was the leading scorer in each game and tied Rider's Jerry Johnson for the most points scored in the tournament (42). Cook was named to the all-tournament team for his efforts.

Coppenrath vs. Hartford: Vermont senior Taylor Coppenrath has faced Hartford only five times during his career (he missed all three meetings last season with a broken wrist), and the Hawks hold the 3-2 edge in those games. Coppenrath did his part in those meetings, averaging 20.4 ppg against the Hawks. Of the 15 players on the Hartford roster, only four have ever laced it up against the reigning two-time America East Player of the Year (Regan, Goode, Cook and Ford).

Goode Results: Hartford senior Trevor Goode needs only one more basket to tie a career-high for points in a season. After scoring 75 points as a sophomore, Goode was expected to be a starter last season but saw only limited action due to severe asthma. After a change in medication, Goode has recovered this season and has started every game.

Remember Me?: Junior Charles Ford has played well when the Hawks have faced the Catamounts. He's averaged 18.3 ppg in four games against Vermont and has scored in double figures in every game. His most memorable game came on January 20, 2002, when he scored a career-high 30 points on 9-of-11 shooting (4-of-4 from three) in a 78-65 win at the Chase Family Arena. Ford, who missed the second meeting that season against UVM due to injury, also helped hold T.J. Sorrentine to 10 points.

15 for 500: Charles Ford needs only 15 more points to reach 500 for his career. The only Hartford player currently on the roster who has scored more career points is classmate Aaron Cook (843).

Lonely Road: Hartford is 2-1 at home this season but has struggled on the road. The Hawks are 0-4 thus far on the road in 2004-05 and have lost their last nine road contests. Hartford's last win on the road came last season at New Hampshire (January 28, 2004).

Crying Foul: Over the first nine games the Hawks have been whistled for 218 fouls (an average of 24.2 per game). The result is an overwhelming advantage for opponents at the free throw line. Hartford opponents have attempted 259 free throws, over 100 more attempts than the Hawks (155). Opponents have made 174 of 259 attempts (67 percent) while the Hawks are 93 of 155 (60 percent).

Magic Number: The number 40 was significant for the Hartford offense last season. The Hawks were 11-5 when they shot 40 percent or better from the floor. More importantly, Hartford was 1-12 when it shot worse than 40 percent. This season, the Hawks have shot over 40 percent in all but two games and are 3-4 when reaching the mark.

Magic Number Extra: The win over Albany on January 25, 2004, in which the Hawks shot 38 percent from the field, was Hartford's first win while shooting worse than 40 percent since February 5, 2002 (a 59-47 win over Maine at home).

Home Is Where the "W" Is: Hartford finished the 2003-04 regular season with a 7-5 home record. Two years ago, the team set a school record for most home wins in a season (11). Hartford was 25-9 the past three seasons at home, the most wins during a three-year span in the 15-year history of the Chase Family Arena. The Hawks have won 25 of their last 33 home games, including 15 of the last 21. The win over Dartmouth earlier this season was the 100th in the Sports Center, which opened in January 1990.

Sharing the Ball: The Hawks had 19 assists in the win over Dartmouth, their highest total since the 2002-03 season. The last time Hartford had as many assists in a game was against Concordia College on January 21, 2003 (21 assists in a 101-51 victory). Junior Charles Ford had seven assists in the loss at Brown, the highest single-game total this year for the Hawks and the most since Rich Baker last season at UMBC.

Milestone Watch: Junior Aaron Cook could become the 20th Hartford men's basketball player to score 1,000 points in a career this season, needing 157 points to eclipse the mark. He also stands fourth all-time at the school in three-pointers, needing just 23 more treys to tie the record (171) held by Mantas Storpirstis (1998-2002).

Injury Bugged: Last season was not a healthy one for the Hawks. Hartford played with only seven scholarship athletes at times and lost leading scorer and rebounder Jerell Parker for the season. Coach Harrison hopes things will be different this season, as sophomore Rich Baker is the only player who will not be available for today's game. He tore his quad tendon in the offseason and is expected to be back by January.

2003-04 Season Recap: The Hawks were ravaged by injuries for most of the regular season and limped to a 12-17 overall record, finishing sixth in the America East with a 6-12 mark. Hartford started playing better toward the end of the season when players became healthy and advanced to the America East Championship semifinals for the third straight season, falling to eventual champion Vermont.

Fresh Faces: Filling the gaps in the Hawks lineup this season will be five new faces. Three of the newcomers hail from junior college programs, including David Ruffin (Connors State College), Demarcquez Rembert (Collin County CC) and Tony Lalor (Westchester CC). The group joins incoming freshmen Brian Glowiak (New Britain HS) and Fred Kounkorgo (Notre Dame Prep). Ruffin and Lalor could crack the starting lineup during the season. Lalor is an inside presence who can rebound and block shots. Ruffin, a wing player, can take players off the dribble and is a tenacious defender. Rembert and Glowiak are threats from behind the three-point line, both with deep range. Kounkorgo, a forward, will have to battle for minutes off the bench.

Sign on the Dotted Line: Larry Harrison signed a two-year contract extension in 2003 to remain the head coach at the University of Hartford through April 2007. Harrison has completed four years of his original five-year deal. Terms of the extension were undisclosed.

About The Coach: Head Coach Larry Harrison enters his fifth season at the helm of the Hartford program. Harrison had previously served as an assistant coach at DePaul University, the University of Cincinnati and American University. Since 1989, Harrison's teams have earned seven bids to the NCAA Tournament and three NIT bids. Harrison is well known for being an excellent recruiter. While at Cincinnati, Harrison's recruiting skills brought in current NBA players such as Danny Fortson and Kenyon Martin.

Who's Missing: Hartford loses three players from last year's squad. Gone are former seniors Ryan Stys, Jerell Parker and Louis Bosley, who exhausted their four years of eligibility. Stys finished his career eighth on the all-time scoring list at Hartford and was a third team all-conference pick. Parker led the Hawks in scoring and rebounding in 2002-03 and was an all-conference selection but played only six games last year due to injury.

Working Overtime: Hartford did not play a single overtime game in 2003-04, but the Hawks are 3-2 under Larry Harrison in overtime games. The Hawks are 3-3 all-time in double-overtime games.

Captains Named: Senior Sean Regan and junior Aaron Cook were named captains of the 2004-05 team.

It's All About the Three: Entering tonight's game the Hawks have hit a three-point basket in 391 consecutive games. The last time the Hawks did not hit a three-point basket in a game was over 13 years ago, January 16, 1991 at Siena in a 54-51 loss.

All-Time Records: The University of Hartford enters today's game with a 669-713 (.484) all-time record. Hartford's all-time Division I record stands at 248-328 (.431). Finally, the Hawks have compiled a record of 148-162 (.477) in conference games (America East and North Atlantic Conference).
