Wednesday's Game: Hartford will face Rider University on the first day of the Oneida Bingo & Casino Classic. The Broncos have lost three straight games and enter the game with a 4-4 record.

Thursday's Game: The Hawks will face either the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay or North Dakota State University. If Hartford beats Rider on Wednesday, the Hawks will face the WGB/NDSU winner in the championship game at 8:30 p.m. EST. If Hartford loses to Rider, the Hawks will face the WGB/NDSU loser in the consolation game at 6 p.m. EST.

Hartford's Last Game: Hartford suffered its worst loss of the season at Arkansas on December 23, falling 87-55 at Bud Walton Arena. The Razorbacks held the Hawks to a season-low 18 first-half points and pulled out to a commanding 45-18 lead at the break. Arkansas used a full-court press to force Hartford into 14 turnovers in the stanza, and the Hawks never got into an offensive rhythm. Hartford played better in the second half, scoring 37 points while committing only six turnovers. Arkansas shot 58 percent for the game, including 13-of-20 from three-point range. Ronnie Brewer scored a game-high 23 points on 9-of-12 shooting for the Razorbacks while Aaron Cook led the Hawks with nine points.

Scouting the Broncos: Rider enters Wednesday's contest having lost its last three games. The Broncos have played a lot of close games this season, pulling out wins over Marist and Iona by a single point while losing to Fairleigh Dickinson and Delaware by two points. Senior guard Jerry Johnson leads the team in scoring at 14.6 ppg, the only Rider player averaging double figures. He's led the team in scoring in five of their eight games, including a season-high 27-point performance against FDU. Five other players average 8.0 ppg or better, including leading rebounder Jason Thompson (5.4 rpg), a freshman forward.

What Went Wrong vs. Arkansas: Hartford had trouble with the Arkansas fullcourt pressure in the first half and committed 14 turnovers. The Razorbacks took advantage and scored 45 points in the stanza, a season high for a Hartford opponent. Arkansas shot 57 percent from the field and 65 percent from three-point range for the game, also season highs for a Hartford opponent.

Tournament Play: The last time Hartford won an in-season tournament was the 1998 Phoenix Classic in Hartford, CT (with wins over Yale and Central Connecticut). The Hawks are 3-11 and have never won an in-season tournament under head coach Larry Harrison.

The Series: The Hawks have never faced any of teams in the Oneida Bingo & Casino Classic field.

Up Next: Hartford will ring in the new year in Burlington, VT, where it will face the University of Vermont on Sunday, January 2 at 1 p.m. The Hawks have lost their last four meetings with the Wildcats, who were picked to win the America East in the conference's preseason poll.

America East Notes: The Hawks are 14-7 all-time in conference openers since joining the North Atlantic Conference for the 1984-85 season ... last season Hartford opened the conference season with a loss at Maine (87-63) ... the Hawks finished sixth in the conference last season with a 6-12 record ... Hartford was 5-4 in conference home games last season and just 1-8 in conference road games (the one victory was at New Hampshire) ... the North Atlantic Conference merged with the Seaboard Conference in 1989 and later changed its name to the America East Conference prior to the 1996-97 academic year.

Home Is Where the "W" Is: Hartford finished the 2003-04 regular season with a 7-5 home record. Two years ago, the team set a school record for most home wins in a season (11). Hartford was 25-9 the past three seasons at home, the most wins during a three-year span in the 15-year history of the Chase Family Arena. The Hawks have won 25 of their last 33 home games, including 15 of the last 21. The win over Dartmouth earlier this season was the 100th in the Sports Center, which opened in January 1990.

Lonely Road: Hartford is 2-1 at home this season but has struggled on the road. The Hawks are 0-3 thus far on the road in 2004-05 and have lost their last eight road contests. Hartford's last win on the road came last season at New Hampshire (January 28, 2004).

Crying Foul: Over the first seven games the Hawks have been whistled for 170 fouls (an average of 24.3 per game). The result is an overwhelming advantage for opponents at the free throw line. Hartford opponents have attempted 207 free throws, almost double the amount the Hawks have attempted (111). Opponents have made 135 of 207 attempts (65 percent) while the Hawks are 70 of 111 (63 percent).

Home Openers: How have the Hawks fared in home openers since jumping to Division I in 1984-85? The win over Dartmouth on December 2 made the Hawks 11-10 overall in home openers, including a perfect 5-0 during head coach Larry Harrison's tenure.

Sharing the Ball: The Hawks had 19 assists in the win over Dartmouth, their highest total since the 2002-03 season. The last time Hartford had as many assists in a game was against Concordia College on January 21, 2003 (21 assists in a 101-51 victory). Junior Charles Ford had seven assists in the loss at Brown, the highest single-game total this year for the Hawks and the most since Rich Baker last season at UMBC.

Milestone Watch: Junior Aaron Cook could become the 20th Hartford men's basketball player to score 1,000 points in a career this season, needing 199 points to eclipse the mark. He also stands fourth all-time at the school in three-pointers, needing just 30 more treys to tie the record (171) held by Mantas Storpirstis (1998-2002).

Magic Number: The number 40 was significant for the Hartford offense last season. The Hawks were 11-5 when they shot 40 percent or better from the floor. More importantly, Hartford was 1-12 when it shot worse than 40 percent. This season, the Hawks have shot over 40 percent in all but one game and are 2-4 when reaching the mark.

Magic Number Extra: The win over Albany on January 25, 2004, in which the Hawks shot 38 percent from the field, was Hartford's first win while shooting worse than 40 percent since February 5, 2002 (a 59-47 win over Maine at home).

Injury Bugged: Last season was not a healthy one for the Hawks. Hartford played with only seven scholarship athletes at times and lost leading scorer and rebounder Jerell Parker for the season. Coach Harrison hopes

things will be different this season, as sophomore Rich Baker is the only player who will not be available for today's game. He tore his quad tendon in the offseason and is expected to be back by January.

20-20 Vision: Last season, Aaron Cook became the first Hartford player to register back-to-back 20-point games since Darrick Jackson during the 1999-2000 season. Jackson scored 22 points against Harvard on January 31 and then followed with 25 points against New Hampshire on February 3. Cook scored a career-high 28 points in the season-opening win over Concordia and then followed that with a 20-point effort at UMass.

Who's Missing: Hartford loses three players from last year's squad. Gone are former seniors Ryan Stys, Jerell Parker and Louis Bosley, who exhausted their four years of eligibility. Stys finished his career eighth on the all-time scoring list at Hartford and was a third team all-conference pick. Parker led the Hawks in scoring and rebounding in 2002-03 and was an all-conference selection but played only six games last year due to injury.

2003-04 Season Recap: The Hawks were ravaged by injuries for most of the regular season and limped to a 12-17 overall record, finishing sixth in the America East with a 6-12 mark. Hartford started playing better toward the end of the season when players became healthy and advanced to the America East Championship semifinals for the third straight season, falling to eventual champion Vermont.

Fresh Faces: Filling the gaps in the Hawks lineup this season will be five new faces. Three of the newcomers hail from junior college programs, including David Ruffin (Connors State College), Demarquez Rembert (Collin County CC) and Tony Lalor (Westchester CC). The group joins incoming freshmen Brian Glowiak (New Britain HS) and Fred Kounkorgo (Notre Dame Prep). Ruffin and Lalor could crack the starting lineup during the season. Lalor is an inside presence who can rebound and block shots. Ruffin, a wing player, can take players off the dribble and is a tenacious defender. Rembert and Glowiak are threats from behind the three-point line, both with deep range. Kounkorgo, a forward, will have to battle for minutes off the bench.

Working Overtime: Hartford did not play a single overtime game in 2003-04, but the Hawks are 3-2 under Larry Harrison in overtime games. The Hawks are 3-3 all-time in double-overtime games.

It's All About the Three: Entering tonight's game the Hawks have hit a three-point basket in 389 consecutive games. The last time the Hawks did not hit a three-point basket in a game was over 13 years ago, January 16, 1991 at Siena in a 54-51 loss.

All-Time Records: The University of Hartford enters today's game with a 668-712 (.484) all-time record. Hartford's all-time Division I record stands at 247-327 (.431). Finally, the Hawks have compiled a record of 148-162 (.477) in conference games (America East and North Atlantic Conference).

Sign on the Dotted Line: Larry Harrison signed a two-year contract extension in 2003 to remain the head coach at the University of Hartford through April 2007. Harrison has completed four years of his original five-year deal. Terms of the extension were undisclosed.

About The Coach: Head Coach Larry Harrison enters his fifth season at the helm of the Hartford program. Harrison had previously served as an assistant coach at DePaul University, the University of Cincinnati and American University. Since 1989, Harrison's teams have earned seven bids to the NCAA Tournament and three NIT bids. Harrison is well known for being an excellent recruiter. While at Cincinnati, Harrison's recruiting skills brought in current NBA players such as Danny Fortson and Kenyon Martin.
