

SUGGESTED CURRICULUM FOR A B.A. DEGREE IN ECONOMICS

This is a sample program and should be used only as a guide to setting up schedules. It is not necessary to adhere strictly to the following B.A. program; it is provided only as a guide. EC 110 and M 110, M 112 must be taken in the Freshman year. Within the 30 credits of upper-class courses in economics, EC 312, EC 311 and QNT 230 are required. In addition, up to 6 of the 30 credits may be selected in related fields. (E.g., quantitative methods, finance). A total of 120 credits minimum is required for the B.A. degree.
