

SUGGESTED CURRICULUM FOR A B.A. DEGREE IN SOCIOLOGY

Majors in Sociology must complete the five core courses (SOC 110,242,343,418 and 440). Majors must also select one area of concentration from which they must complete at least three courses (nine credit hours). In addition, students must take at least two courses at the 300-level and two courses at the 400-level from the courses listed within any area of concentration.
