Conditions of Participation

All applicants are asked to review and sign the following statement that constitutes conditions for participation in all University of Hartford sponsored study abroad programs.

1. I understand and agree that, as a participant in a University of Hartford sponsored study abroad program, I am subject to the student conduct regulations described in the Student Handbook and in the Rules and Regulations of the University of Hartford. I further understand that, if I am attending an overseas university as part of a University of Hartford program, I am also subject to the conduct regulations of that institution.
2. I agree to participate fully in all portions of the program and agree that any deviation I will make from the program design must be approved in advance in writing by the program director.
3. I agree that the program director may terminate my participation in the program at any time if: 1) I engage in actions endangering to myself or others, or 2) my conduct is considered to be detrimental or incompatible with the best interest and welfare of the program. I further agree, if expelled from the program, to be responsible for all expenses incurred in returning to the United States.
4. I understand that I am subject to the laws of the host country and agree to abide by those laws. It is further understood that University of Hartford may be limited in its ability to provide assistance in the event of arrest and may also institute disciplinary proceedings.
5. I am aware of the nature and the cost of the program and will guarantee that all financial obligations will be met in the time specified.
6. I agree to notify the program director if I am planning extended individual travel during the program. Where possible, I will provide the director with details of the proposed trip including plane, bus, and train schedules. I understand that the University of Hartford will not be held liable in any event.
7. I understand that University of Hartford reserves the right to cancel programs in the case of insufficient participation or for other reasons deemed appropriate. University of Hartford also reserves the right to make changes to the program (such as program director) or alterations in the program’s proposed schedule and itinerary. I further understand that should the program, or any portion of the program, be cancelled, University of Hartford shall have no responsibility beyond the refund of all recoverable funds paid to University of Hartford by participants. Minor alterations in the programs will not result in refunds.
8. I understand that any responsibility that University of Hartford has for students participating in University of Hartford sponsored programs terminates once the program is finished.
9. I understand that students participating in University of Hartford programs need to be willing to learn about their host cultures and be open to new ideas even though they may be culturally challenging. Consequently, I will demonstrate a respect for the host culture even though I may not agree with all aspects of that culture, and I understand that behavior that is inconsistent with this statement may lead to my removal from the program.
10. I understand that the course cost is \$4390 for undergraduate and \$4450 for graduate based on double occupancy (\$710 extra for single) including airfare, hotel, SOS emergency assistance, textbooks, overnight camping in the desert, New Year’s event, museum visits, and transportation to course related visits. I am responsible for contracting cancellation insurance on my own.
11. Depending on the date my withdrawal notification is received by the Study Aboard Programs, these penalties are:

Ninety-one days prior to departure or earlier:	\$100 plus expenses already incurred on my behalf
One to thirty days prior to departure:	\$500 plus expenses already incurred on my behalf
Date of or after departure:	Full program fee

Further, I understand that in those instances when airline tickets and/or other services have been purchased by the University of Hartford on my behalf, I will be responsible for any cancellation penalties arising out of my withdrawal from the program. I further understand that I will be responsible for negotiating directly with the appropriate agencies regarding any penalties or refunds caused by my withdrawal from the program.

I have read and understand the conditions governing my participation in University of Hartford study abroad programs. I further understand the possible actions that will be taken should I act in a manner that is inconsistent with these conditions.
