Summer Housing at the University of Hartford is available to University of Hartford students enrolled in Summerterm classes at the University or who are working full-time for a University department. To obtain an assignment, a non-refundable deposit of \$100 must be paid to the SASC Office (see top corner box), along with the students housing application. This deposit will be applied toward the students summer room charge. Students will be assigned to a space in **C Complex** based on the date of their housing deposit. Students may request a single room, however, **MOST** students will be assigned to a double occupancy room. There are no guarantees that a request for a single room will be granted. Students with special medical needs **MUST** contact the Dean of Students Office at 860-768-4260 for instructions on how to obtain medical housing.

****Residential Students** taking Session 1 classes are to remain in their current assignment after the residence halls close for the spring semester. Residential Life will contact you after graduation with instructions to move into your summer assignment.

****Off Campus students** taking Session 1 classes will check into their assignment after 12:00 noon on Tuesday, May 20, 2008.
